



Anaconda School District Bus Routes:

The Anaconda School District and Tucker Transportation would like to let parent(s)/guardian(s) know which buses are on which routes. Hopefully this will help you know what bus your children will need to ride to and from school. School buses and routes are as follows:

- Bus #80 – Crackerville Road and Opportunity (Northern area of Opportunity)
- Bus #81 – Special Needs and Pre School
- Bus #85 – North Cable Road and Stumptown Road
- Bus #86 – Lost Creek and Galen Road
- Bus #87 – Opportunity (Southern area and Eastern area of Opportunity)
- Bus #88 – West Valley
- Bus #89 – Georgetown Lake

In accordance with Policy 8100 (starting August 29th, 2018) all buses will follow the three mile state law regulation. This regulation prohibits any students that live within three miles of their school from riding a bus. Students that will be eligible to ride will need to live east of the Town Pump (on the east end of town) or west for the Thriftway (on the west end of town). The special needs/Pre School bus is exempt from this regulation. The school buses will still transfer students between the schools as it has done in the past. While the district acknowledges this may be a hardship for some, it is important that we follow our adopted policy and state law.
